Sharon Clark's impeccable scat singing, phrasing and ability to improvise have made her one of the most popular American jazz vocalists in Russia since she first performed in the country on a tour in 2009. After problems with management, at the beginning of 2017 she joined forces with bassist Sergei Vasilyev, who took up managerial duties as well. The March 11 performance at Essé Jazz Club marks the end of a 16-city Russian tour for the Sergei Vasilyev Trio, which besides Clark on vocals also includes Ivan Farmakovskiy on piano and Pavel Timofeyev on drums. Clark promises to round off the tour with a tribute to "The Big Six": Ella Fitzgerald, Sarah Vaughan, Billie Holiday, Carmen McCrae, Shirley Horn and Nancy Wilson. Tickets from RUB 1,200
